To whom it may concern:

At its meeting on September 20, 2000, the TRACS Accreditation Commission voted to grant Tennessee Temple University (TTU) initial Accreditation. At its meeting on November 29, 2005, the TRACS Accreditation Commission granted TTU Reaffirmation I status. The institution retained this status until they merged with Carolina University (CU) (formerly Piedmont International University) of Winston-Salem, NC, on April 30, 2015. Appropriate teach-out plans are in place, and key TTU programs were approved for continuation at CU.

TRACS is recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDOE), the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), and the International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE) for the pre-accreditation (candidacy) and accreditation of Christian postsecondary institutions that offer certificates and diplomas, and associate, baccalaureate, and graduate degrees, including institutions that offer distance education.
